At long last we have received approval (as per below) from the Minister of Conservation for our proposal to increase the EHC on Used Oil Containers, from 5 to 10 cents per litre capacity.

Because we are already 7 days into September the 90 day Notice of the increase will take effect October 1 which will mean the actual increase will commence January 1, 2011.


